Specifying a date range for your search can speed the search process. The indexes for Birth, Death and Marriage Certificates have date restrictions due to government regulation. 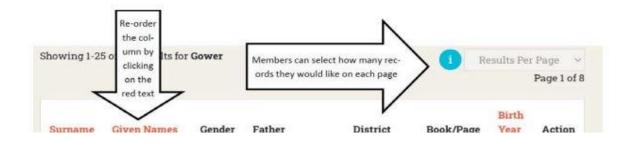
Use the wildcards to search for parts of names, or names that begin or end with certain characters, \* for multiple characters and ? for one character. eg. If searching for Joraslafsky or anything similar, enter \*lafsky to find anything that ends in lafsky.

If searching for O'Dea or anything similar, enter O?Dea to find that name. The ? Wildcard replaces the apostrophe.

Likewise, if you want to find someone born in 1888 with Last name of Longbottom or similar, you enter Date 1888 and Last name Lon\*. Note - the wildcard search requires 3 characters plus the wildcard symbol. This will give you hundreds of results to wade through

### Sorting of columns

Columns with titles in RED text can be re-ordered. Simply click on the red text to re-order the column. Member have access to the re-order feature for more of the columns and also the ability to change the number of records displayed per page

In there will be explanations for the symbols used in the Birth, Death and Marriage registrations databases.

### Birth, Death and Marriage 'Symbol' Field.

These abbreviations are used by indexers to qualify the data recorded, and may signify that additional information is available on the original certificate. Up to two symbols may be recorded for any record.

### Partial view

- A We have amended data during extraction to correct an error because we believe that a researcher will be mislead by data on the certificate, eg date of death after a data of burial, age at death less than age at marriage, a deceased person is the informant, or an end of year clerical error. This is somewhat similar to symbol 'E' below.
- **B** Data from both the Registrar's certificate and the District copy were used to compile the entry because the Registrar's certificate was damaged or illegible in parts.
- C An official correction exists on the Registrar's certificate that may or may not be on the District copy.

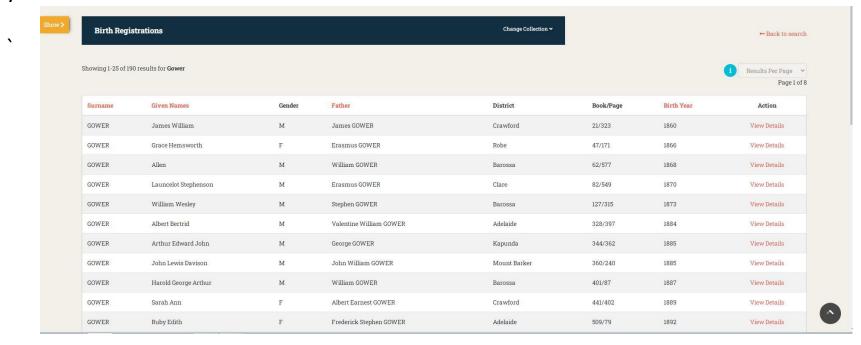

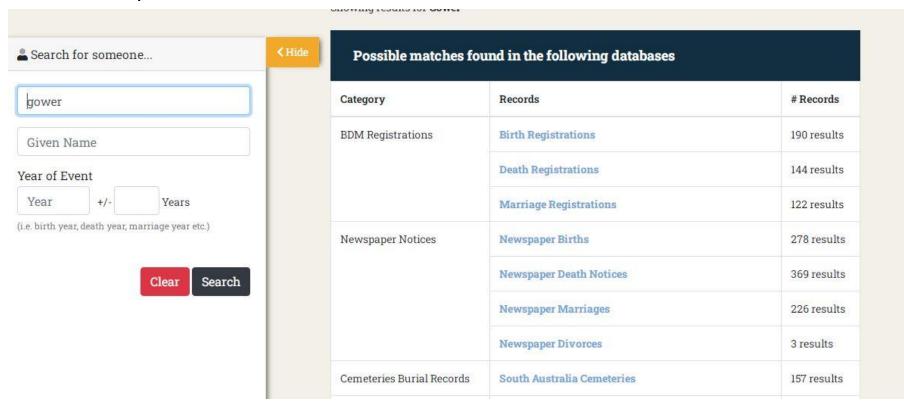

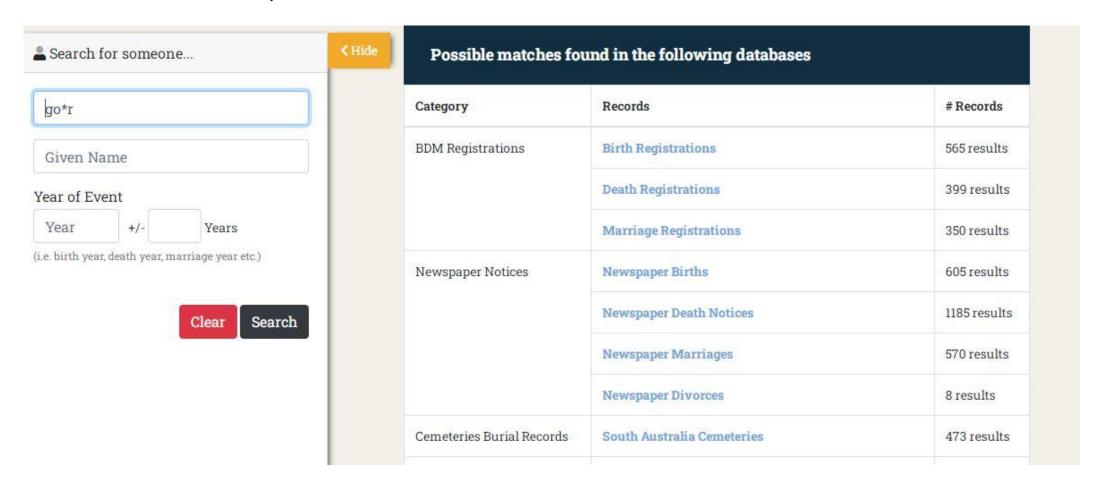

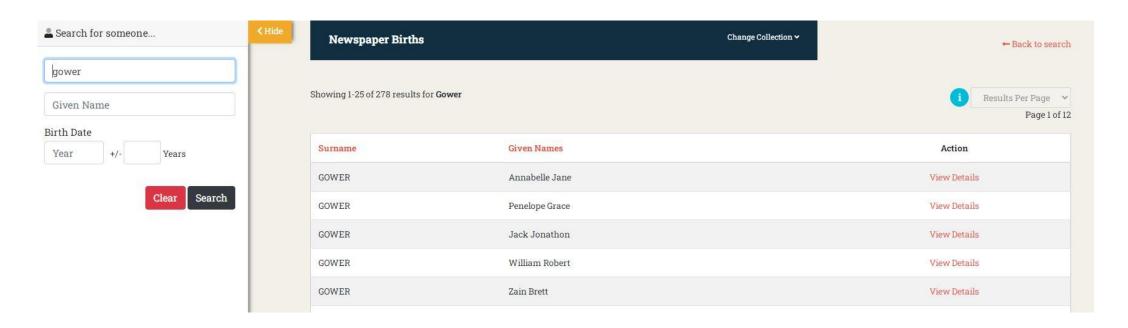

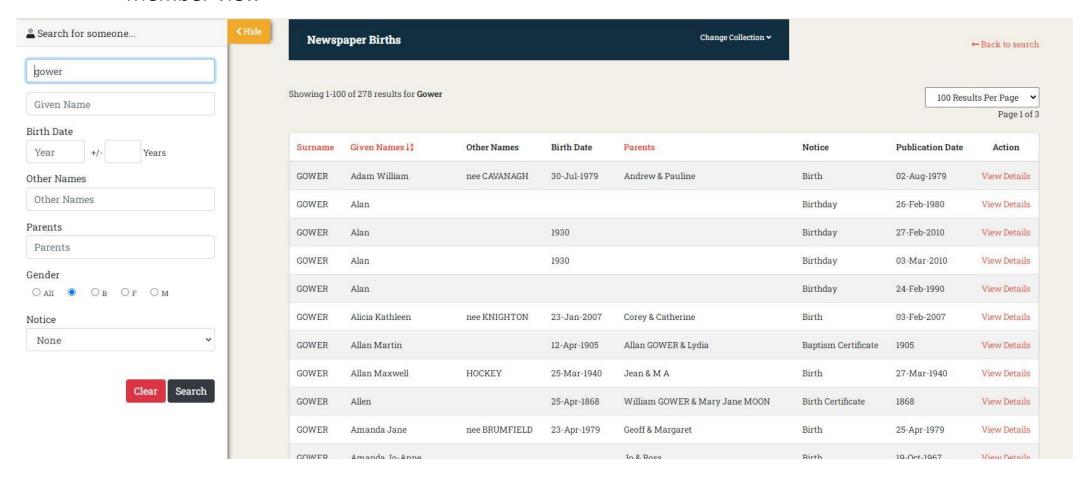

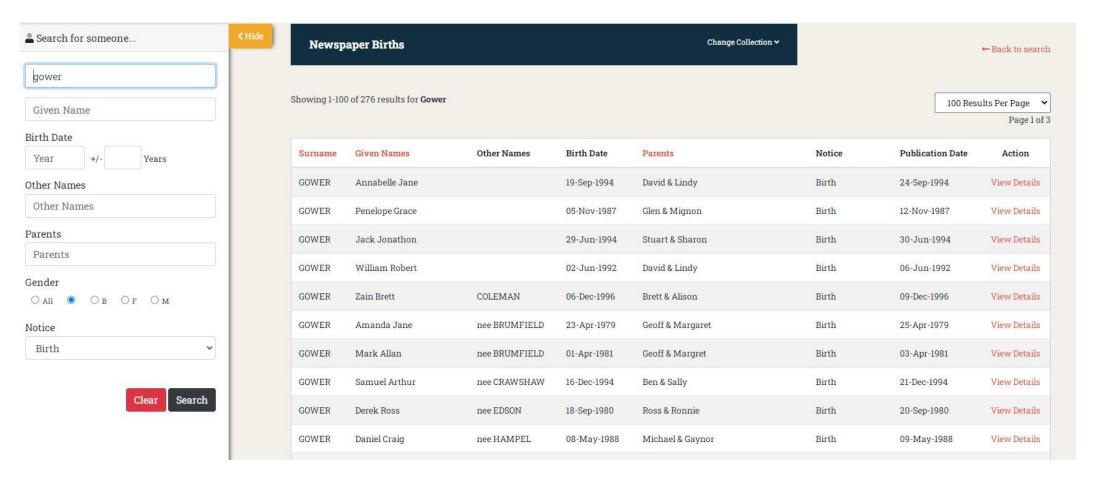



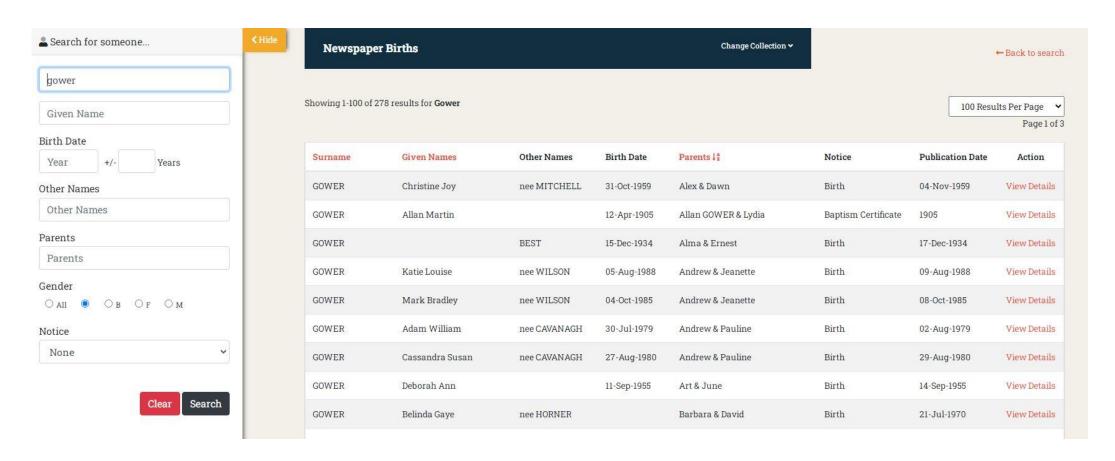




### Note: Death registrations after 1967 are not available

Genealogy SA holds copies of the original District Registration Certificates for Births, Deaths, and Marriages from which this index entry was derived. The original Certificates hold additional information that many researchers find valuable. However, Genealogy SA is not permitted by law to provide an image copy of these original Certificates, but we can provide a transcription of the Certificate. The Certificate information content varies according to when it was created, and you can see tables here showing what you can expect to see. There is also a link helow that shows what to expect on the

View details - Non-member

Fields marked Members Only means that there is some data recorded there

Any field with Not Recorded greyed out in it means that nothing was recorded BUT, there may be additional information available in the Society Library



As we have seen, there are numerous different ways to search and filter and sort the results.

What you get from your efforts are dependant on what you put into the search parameters

So, to reflect, the steps are:-

- 1. Check Search hints, what is available and when, abbreviations used and what's in each database
- 2. Decide what search parameters you are going to use
- 3. Decide on what filtering and sorting you will be doing
- 4. Keep your initial search as simple as you can. This way you can get the maximum results for your effort. You can always expand the search parameters later

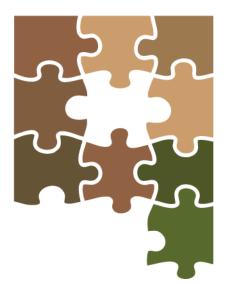
